Directions:

If you have a normal car, it is best to park it at the end of the road and walk along the track. There is no public transport, though lifts might be arranged in advance. Some basic overnight accommodation, or camping, may be available by advance arrangement.

Head for 'Buccleuch' on the B711. From the roadside, head down the track 100m, taking the left fork which passes by the front of East Buccleuch farmhouse. Continue past a large green barn, keeping the Rankleburn river to your right for just over a mile. You will eventually see a house to the right. Cross the footbridge and the Generator Shed is 200 yards to the left.
